ORDER

Urban Sanitation being an important segment in Rebuild Kerala Initiative programme a capital investment of Rs.2750 Crore is envisaged in the RKDP in this sector and an amount of Rs.120 Crore is readily available from the Policy Development Loan availed from the World Bank as per the decision of the 5th meeting of High Level Empowered Committee. Local Self Government Department has submitted a concept note to Rebuild Kerala Initiative in this regard.

In the review meeting chaired by the Chief Secretary on 6th July 2019, it was decided to designate AMRUT Mission and IMPACT Kerala Ltd. as implementing agencies for projects taken up by Local Self Government Department under RKI in this sector. An Action Plan for Management of Urban Liquid Waste in Kerala was prepared by IMPACT Kerala Ltd and submitted to LSGD on 5th October, 2020. This action plan aims at developing a workable programme in liquid waste management in the ULBs in the State. The first component of this plan is the siting of the treatment facilities based on a spatial analysis and assessing the capacities of the treatment facilities required. Subsequently it was decided that projects which are available with the LSGs can be taken up for presentation to RKI. In the context, Managing Director, IMPACT Kerala Ltd has submitted a request for enabling the company to take up the projects in this sector under RKI elaborating the following procedure intended to be adhered to.

- i. IMPACT Kerala Ltd will submit a project brief to RKI indicating the location, capacity and

tentative cost of the project and cost of preparation of DPR to RKI.

ii. Once the brief is approved by RKI and funds for preparation of DPR is made available to IMPACT Kerala Ltd by RKI, IMPACT Kerala Ltd shall get the DPR prepared by the LSG by engaging a competent consultant.

iii. The DPR vetted and finalised by IMPACT Kerala Ltd shall be submitted to RKI for approval.

iv. Once RKI has approved the DPR and sufficient funds allocated for the project, the Technical Committee constituted by the Government for IMPACT Kerala Ltd vide Order read as third paper above shall consider the DPR and accord technical sanction for the same after the necessary technical scrutiny.

v. After the technical sanction is obtained and the availability of funds ensured by RKI, the IMPACT Kerala Ltd shall implement the project following the same protocol as that for KIIFB funded projects implemented by IMPACT Kerala Ltd., as approved by its Board of Directors in its 9th meeting on 8th September, 2020, as amended from time to time by the Board of Directors.

Government examined the matter in details and are pleased to approve IMPACT Kerala Ltd as an implementing agency of projects for Septage Management facilities in Local Self Government Institutions included in Rebuild Kerala Initiative which will function adhering to the above stated procedures and conditions.


